CLIMATE EDUCATION AND GREEN SKILLS

- Tutorial times to discuss actions
- Theme days and week/project work
- Decrease paper use – minimal printing including parent letters
- Add note to emails about printing
- Add to pupil forum agenda and invite pupils to working group
- Metal Pilgrim drinks bottles
- Paperless payslips
- Reach More Parents where possible to avoid printing
- Food orders increase awareness of where the food is coming from eg UK or further?



BIODIVERSITY AND NATURE

- Take home students out into nature and continue with well being walks
- Allow grass to grown long/ wild flower meadow
- Install water butts
- Increase bird boxes
- Register for Nature Park/ create a habitat map



DECARBONISATION AND NET ZERO

- Decrease/ regulate heating within bases
- Implement strict timers to try and reduce oil consumption
- Investigate an electric minibus
- Encourage use of electric cars – provide chargers (at bases with electrical capacity)
- Food waste composted



ADAPTATION AND RESILIENCE

- Ensure we are flood resilient through a flood analysis
- Investigate solar again/wind turbine
- Consider heating alternatives
- Install water butts
- Regular working group meetings
