Outcomes for pupils across cohorts:

Of note when assessing whole school data

There were 60-year 11 pupils on the Go4Schools roll in total from the January consensus. 2 of these pupils had left the School and 2 had been withdrawn, with 1 pupil only being entered for Maths and English. 4 pupils produced no exam evidence.

English language

- Boys are slightly below targets compared to Girls.14.3% (3) vs 3.7% (1)
- 59.3% (16) girls hit their targets vs 42.9% (9) of boys
- 90% of FSM pupils hit their targets vs 83% of their peers
- 83.3% of PPI pupils hit their targets vs 82.6% of their peers
- 83.7% of ASD pupils hit their targets vs 82.6% of their peers
- 100% of ASD pupils hit their target or excelled it
- 100% Amber Hill pupils were on or above target
- 75% of Baumber pupils were on or above target (1 pupil didn't hit their target)
- 100% of home taught pupils were on or above target
- 91.7% of Lincoln pupils were on or above target
- 75% of pupils with an EHCP were on or above target vs 87.6% of their peers
- 100% of TAC pupils hit their targets vs 81% of their peers

English Literature

- 55% of PPI pupils were on or above target vs 70% of their peers
- 44% of PPI pupils were below target vs 24% of their peers
- 66% of ASD pupils were on or above target vs 65% of their peers
- 60% of Amber Hill pupils hit their targets
- 40% of Baumber pupils hit their targets (2 vs 3)
- 87.5% of Lincoln pupils hit their targets
- 66% of pupils in the home hit their targets

- 100% of CIN pupils fell below their target (2) vs 25% of their peers (5)
- 40% of EHCP pupils met or exceeded their targets vs 78% of their peers
- 66% of TAC pupils met or exceeded their targets vs 66% of their peers

Mathematics

- 26.1% of boys were below target vs 17.9% of girls (1 pupil difference)
- 38% of FSM pupils below target vs 13.9% of their peers (5 in each cohort)
- 35.7% of PPI pupils below target vs 16.2% of their peers (5 in each cohort)
- 35.7% (5) ASD pupils below target vs 16.2% (6) of their peers
- 21% of ASD pupils on target vs 31% of their peers
- 100% of pupils in the ASD centre hit their targets
- 82% of Amber Hill pupils on or above target
- 60% of Baumber pupils on or above target
- 74% of home taught pupils on or above target
- 91.7% of Lincoln pupils on or above target
- 35% of EHCP (6) pupils below target vs 14.7% (5) of their peers

Science

- 35% of boys (5) missed their targets vs 25% (5) girls
- 89% of FSM pupils met or exceeded target vs 63% of their peers
- 89% of PPI pupils met or exceeded their target vs 64% of their peers
- ASD pupils were slightly below their peers with 37.5% (3) below target vs 29% (7) of their peers
- 69% (9) of Amber Hill pupils met or exceeded targets
- 67% (2) of Baumber pupils met or exceeded targets
- 66.7% (7) of Lincoln pupils met or exceeded targets
- 100% (4) of home taught met or exceeded targets
- 50% (2) TAC pupils below target vs 26% (8) of their peers
