I am really excited to start at Baumber as I get to wear my own clothes to feel comfortable while I learn!









On arriving to base I can check the changes board and the visual calendar where I can see what events are coming up this month, this is also available online for when I want to check from home.






There are four different classroom spaces at Baumber.




