Every member of staff completes annual Cyber Threat training, and is kept informed of online threats such as spoof emails, phishing, vishing, middle man, spear phishing and so on. They are all available to give you advice if you have been the subject of any cyber-attack.

If you are concerned about a specific threat to you, such as online bullying, you can approach any member of staff who can then discuss this with a member of the Safeguarding Team, your Base Champion, or Online Safety Coordinator.
