



Parent/Carer School Agreement

At Pilgrim School we believe in working closely together with families so that together we can support your child to access education successfully. We have therefore produced a set of guidelines which will help us to do that. Our priority is to help your child be

Safe, Prepared and Responsible.

Safe: I agree to support my child:

- To follow the Pilgrim "Safe Internet" rules by learning how to use the internet safely e.g. not giving out their contact details, using the privacy settings on social media sites e.g. Facebook. By checking they do not use the "Dark net." By knowing who they talk to online. By being vigilant to ensure they have not arranged to meet someone they have spoken to online.
- To use their phone safely in and out of school hours e.g. by them not sending/receiving nude selfies. To help them to know how to block offensive/ bullying messages.
- To Follow the Pilgrim rules on not bringing or using alcohol, drugs or cigarettes /tobacco whilst at school and to understand how to make safe, healthy, responsible decisions out of school.

Prepared: I agree to support my child:

- To be ready for the taxi.
- To be on time to school and to all lessons.
- To be ready to learn by having a pen, pencil and ruler for the start of each lesson.
- In lessons to have their phone on silent. I agree not to send/receive text messages or phone them during lesson time. If I, or they have a problem and we need to contact each other URGENTLY we will contact the school office and ask them to communicate the message for us.
- To encourage them to be modestly dressed, which I understand means they will cover their stomach, chest, tops of their legs or large areas of their body. I will ensure they wear a top with wide straps that covers underwear.

Responsible: I agree to:

- Encourage my child to work with staff to try to find ways to support them when they are anxious, worried etc.
- Help them develop respectful relationships which means I will support them to talk appropriately to other people and expect others to do the same to them.
- Help them to bring healthy snacks and food to school. (Energy drinks are not allowed in school.)
- Attend reviews with Pilgrim and, where appropriate my child's mainstream school, in order to reflect on progress made and agree next steps. I understand that persistent non engagement with reviews could be treated as a safeguarding matter and Pilgrim may inform social care.

I understand that by agreeing to support the Pilgrim Parent/Carer Agreement I am committing to working with all staff to help my child make the most of their time at Pilgrim School.

I acknowledge that I have read the pupil's Code of Conduct and will work together with school in supporting my child to follow this code.

I agree that if staff have any concerns or my child breaks the code of conduct it will be discussed by staff with me and my child. I understand that my child will be expected to take responsibility for their own actions.

I will ensure that The Pilgrim School office will be contacted as soon as it is known that my child will be unable to receive the planned provision.

I agree to let the school office know of any changes to personal contact details i.e. change of address, telephone number as soon as those details are confirmed.

I understand that if 3 consecutive lessons are cancelled by me, the support **may** be suspended pending a review. If my child needs to be absent, I will contact the relevant Pilgrim School base, as soon as possible, on or before the day of the lesson.

I understand that Pilgrim school may need to contact my child's mainstream school as may be necessary in connection with the educational provision.

I understand that Pilgrim school may need to contact other professionals who are, or may be, involved in my child's care.

I agree to inform the school of any medication required during the school day so that it may be stored safely and administered appropriately.
