



Parent/Carer School Agreement for pupils taught in their home or on a 1-1 basis at an alternative venue.

At Pilgrim School we believe in working closely together with families so that together we can support your child to access education successfully. We have therefore produced a set of guidelines which will help us to do that. Our priority is to help your child be

Safe, Prepared and Responsible.

Safe: I agree to support my child:

- To follow the Pilgrim "Safe Internet" rules by learning how to use the internet safely e.g. not giving out their contact details, using the privacy settings on social media sites e.g. Facebook. By checking they do not use the "Dark net." By knowing who they talk to online. By being vigilant to ensure they have not arranged to meet someone they have spoken to on line.
- To use their phone safely in and out of school hours e.g. by them not sending/receiving nude selfies. To help them to know how to block offensive/ bullying messages.
- By ensuring there is responsible adult present. I will ensure the person, if not myself, is aged 18 years or over and is aware of this agreement.

Prepared: I agree to support my child:

- By providing a quiet, safe area for lessons to take place.
- To be ready to learn when the teacher arrives.
- To be ready to learn by having a pen, pencil and ruler for the start of each lesson.
- In lessons to have their phone on silent. I agree not to send/receive text messages during lesson time.
- To encourage them to be modestly dressed, which I understand means they will cover their stomach, chest, tops of their legs or large areas of their body.

Responsible: I agree to:

- Encourage my child to work with teachers to try to find ways to support them when they are anxious, worried etc.
- Help them develop respectful relationships which means I will support them to talk appropriately to other people and expect others to do the same to them.
- Attend reviews with Pilgrim and, where appropriate my child's mainstream school, in order to reflect on progress made and agree next steps. I understand that persistent non engagement with reviews could be treated as a safeguarding matter and Pilgrim may inform social care.

I understand that by agreeing to support the Pilgrim Parent/Carer Agreement I am committing to working with all staff to help my child make the most of their time at Pilgrim School.

I acknowledge that I have read the Pupil Code of Conduct and will work together with school in supporting my child to follow this code.

I agree that if staff have any concerns or my child breaks the Pupil Code of Conduct it will be discussed by staff with me and my child. I understand that my child will be expected to take responsibility for their own actions.

If my child needs to be absent for illness or medical appointments, I will contact the school office, as soon as possible, on or before the day of the lesson.

I agree to let the school office know of any changes to personal contact details i.e. change of address, telephone number as soon as those details are confirmed.
